




ABANDONED CAMPFIRES CAN CAUSE WILDFIRE



BUILD



LOCATE AN EXISTING FIRE RING. PLEASE DO NOT BUILD YOUR OWN.



CLEAR AN AREA AT LEAST 5FT FROM THE FIRES EDGE.



SCRAPE AWAY GRASS, LEAVES, AND NEEDLES DOWN TO MINERAL SOIL.



CUT WOOD IN SHORT LENGTHS AND PILE WITHIN A CLEARED AREA. THEN LIGHT THE FIRE.



SOMETIMES PITS ARE FILLED WITH DEBRIS. REMOVE EXCESS MATERIAL AND DIG A SMALL PIT INTO THE CENTER OF THE FIRE RING TO PLACE YOUR WOOD.



KEEP THE FIRE SMALL. YOU DON'T NEED A LARGE FIRE TO COOK OR PROVIDE WARMTH.



YOUR FIRE MUST NEVER BE LEFT UNATTENDED AND IT MUST BE COMPLETELY EXTINGUISHED BEFORE YOU LEAVE. YOU ARE LIABLE FOR AN ABANDONED CAMPFIRE.

BURN



KEEP A SHOVEL AND A BUCKET OF WATER NEAR BY.



NEVER LEAVE A FIRE UNATTENDED. IT'S AGAINST THE LAW, AND IF YOUR FIRE ESCAPES, YOU CAN BE HELD LIABLE FOR RESULTING DAMAGES AND COSTS.

OUT



USE THE DROWN, STIR, AND FEEL METHOD.

DROWN THE FIRE WITH WATER, STIR THE FIRE DEBRIS WITH YOUR SHOVEL TO WET ALL EMBERS AND ASH.



IF IT'S TOO HOT TO TOUCH, IT'S TOO HOT TO LEAVE!

IF IT'S STILL TOO HOT, TRY THESE STEPS.



TURN WOOD AND COALS OVER TO COMPLETELY WET ALL SIDES.



MOVE DIRT ONTO THE FIRE SITE AND MIX THOROUGHLY TO FULLY SMOTHER IT.
