




# VEHICLES CAN CAUSE WILDFIRE




**DON'T DRIVE ON GRASS**

**NO DRAGGING PARTS**

MAKE SURE YOUR VEHICLE IS PROPERLY MAINTAINED, WITH NOTHING DRAGGING ON THE GROUND.



**CHECK TIRE PRESSURE**

IF YOU HIT A BUMP IN THE ROAD/TRAIL, THE WHEEL CAN COMPRESS, MAKE CONTACT WITH THE GROUND, AND THROW SPARKS.



CARRY A FIRE EXTINGUISHER IN YOUR VEHICLE.




**MAINTAIN BRAKES**

BRAKES WORN TOO THIN MAY CAUSE METAL TO METAL CONTACT, WHICH CAN THROW SPARKS.
