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**WESTON PASS**

Forest Service roads open to motorized vehicles are posted with white arrows. Wilderness areas such as Collegiate Peaks and Mount Massive are by regulation permanently closed to motorized and mechanized vehicles, including mountain bikes. Mileage is measured one way, unless indicated otherwise.

**Weston Pass****Road Number:** FDR 425**Length:** 11 miles, from Highway 24 to forest boundary at top of pass**Road Beginning:** Approximately 5.5 miles south of Leadville on Hwy 24**Road Ending:**

Road continues onto Pike National Forest down to Highway 285 leading to Fairplay.

**Description:**


Road is not maintained for low clearance vehicles on west side of pass. Very rough in places with a few steep pitches. Scenic route along creek with beaver activity. Climbs into high alpine valley above treeline. There is some private land around the pass summit.
