

**Order No. 06-15-03-16-358**  
**14 Day Camping Limit**  
**Umpqua National Forest**  
**North Umpqua Ranger District**

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(a), to provide for an equitable camping experience and protect natural resources, the following acts are prohibited within the North Umpqua Ranger District of the Umpqua National Forest as described below and shown in attached maps Exhibit A through D. The Order is effective beginning September 14, 2016 and ending on September 14, 2018, unless rescinded sooner.

1. CAMPING by any person or group, within the boundaries described below and identified in Exhibit A through Exhibit D maps, for more than 14 days within a 45 day period.  
36 CFR 261.58(a)

**Camping means the temporary use of National Forest System lands for the purpose of overnight occupancy without a permanently-fixed structure.**

Forest Service Road 38/ Steamboat Creek Road corridor's affected area of closure begins at the junction with Forest Service Road 3809 and extends to the junction of Forest Service Road 3821. Steelhead Creek Forest Camp is included and the affected area extends for a half mile radius in all directions from the Forest Camp. The closure is valid within 300' of both sides of all roads as defined by attached maps.

Forest Service Road 4711/ Wright Creek Road corridor's affected area of closure begins at the turn off of Highway 138 and extends to just past the junction of Forest Service Road 290, it includes Wright Creek Campground and is valid within 300' of both sides of FS Road 4711 as defined by the attached maps.

Bogus Creek Dispersed Site on Highway 138, adjacent to and west of Bogus Creek Campground will be affected by the closure as defined by the attached maps.

Steamboat Point, located at the corner of Highway 138 and Forest Service Road 38/Steamboat Creek Road will be affected by the closure as defined by the attached maps.

Forest Service Roads 4714, 4720, and 4750 corridors are affected by the closure and it extends 300' of both sides of all roads as described in the attached maps.

The Illahee Flats Pavilion is affected by the closure and it extends for a half mile radius in all directions from the pavilion.

The following developed campgrounds will also be included in the closure:

- Apple Creek Campground
- Bogus Creek Campground
- Canton Creek Campground
- Coolwater Campground
- Eagle Rock Campground

- Hemlock Lake Campground
- Hemlock Meadows Campground
- Horseshoe Bend Campground
- Island Campground
- Lake in the Woods Campground
- Steamboat Falls Campground
- White Creek Campground
- Wolf Creek Campground

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local Officer of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in Title 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581.
