

Forest Order No. 08-16-16
Mendocino National Forest
Road Closure

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(b), to provide for public safety, the following act is prohibited within the Covelo Ranger District of the Mendocino National Forest. This Order is effective from October 1, 2016, through October 31, 2016.

Being on Forest Road No. M1 (Indian Dick Road), from a point approximately 4.4 miles northeast of the Eel River Work Station to the seasonal gate closure on Boardman Ridge, as shown on the attached map.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of official duty.
2. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
3. Owners or lessees of private land in the area, to the extent necessary to access their land.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.


A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual or \$10,000.00 for an organization or imprisonment for not more than six months or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581.
