**TRAIL CLOSURE
Hayden Pass Fire Area**

Pursuant to 16 United States Code (U.S.C.) § 551 and 36 Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.) § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following act is prohibited on a portion of the Rainbow Trail (NFST 1336) within the Hayden Pass Fire Area on the San Isabel National Forest, Fremont County Colorado, hereinafter the "Restricted Trail". The Restricted Trail is further defined as that section of NFST 1336 between the vehicle restrictor located at the Ranger District boundary north of NFSR 198, and the junction with the Hayden Pass road (NFSR 6). The Restricted Trail is also depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this order as Exhibit A.

The purpose of this Order is to protect public safety due to the continuing impacts of the Hayden Pass wildland fire.

PROHIBITION:

- 1) Using any motorized vehicle on the Restricted Trail. 36 C.F.R. § 261.55(b).

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1) Any federal, state or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force, in the performance of an official duty;
- 2) Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

This Order supersedes, rescinds and replaces Order # PSICC-2016-24, issued August 16, 2016.


This Order shall become effective upon signature, and will remain in effect for one year, or until rescinded, whichever event occurs first.

Violations of these prohibitions are punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for a legal entity other than an individual, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559 and 3571).
