

Closed areas in the National Forests and Grasslands in Texas

Due to storms and excessive rainfall, portions of roads, trails and recreation areas are closed. Forest visitors should always check their surroundings and be aware of hazardous road conditions and the possibility of falling limbs or trees.

Angelina National Forest

- Roads closed to all traffic: Road 302 and segment of Road 300 (For more information, contact Angelina Ranger's Office at 936-897-1068)

Davy Crockett National Forest

<p>Roads closed to all traffic:</p> <p>526B – entire road 526 – from FM 227 to CR1190 518A - entire road 513 – from 558 to Private road 558 – entire road 560A – entire road 533 – entire road 502A – entire road 504 – entire road 553 – from private road to terminus 586 – entire road 588 – entire road 523 – entire road 528B – entire road 539 – entire road 506 – entire road 510B – entire road 563 is closed from the county road to the terminus 591A is closed from the intersection with 591 to the terminus 513 is closed from the intersection of 558 (at the cemetery) north to the private road</p>	<p>Roads closed except for those who need access to their property:</p> <p>521 – from 513 west to terminus 503 – from private land south to terminus 505 – from turnaround to terminus 567 – from property line to terminus. Just the western part is closed to all but local, it is open from the county road until you get through the private.</p>
<p>Ratcliff Lake - The 520 road around the lake is closed to all traffic. Forest visitors can access Dogwood and Lakeshore loops, but not the over flow area or Loblolly loop</p>
