

Closed areas in the National Forests and Grasslands in Texas

Due to storms and excessive rainfall, portions of roads, trails and recreation areas are closed. Forest visitors should always check their surroundings and be aware of hazardous road conditions and the possibility of falling limbs or trees.

Angelina National Forest

- Roads closed to all traffic: Road 302 and segment of Road 300 (For more information, contact Angelina Ranger's Office at 936-897-1068)

Davy Crockett National Forest

Roads closed to all traffic:	Roads closed except for those who need access to their property:
526B – from intersection of 526 to terminus 518A – from intersection of 518 to terminus 526 – from FM 227 east to CR1190 558 - from intersection of 513 southwest to 521 513 – from intersection of 558 north to private road 533 – from intersection of SH 7 to CR 4600 591A – from intersection of 591 to terminus 563 – from intersection of CR4625 to terminus 514A – from intersection of 514 to terminus 502A – from intersection of 502 to terminus 504 – from intersection of 502 to Elmer Smith Road 552 – from Possum Walk Road to terminus 557 – from Louisville Road to terminus 553 – from private road to terminus 523 – from SH 94 to 528 528B – from intersection of 528 to terminus 539 – from Helmic Road to terminus 506 – from FM 2262 to terminus 510B – 1 mile from FM 2262 to terminus 588 - from FM 3154 to terminus 586 – from FM 3154 to terminus 520 – from Dogwood Loop to terminus 560A – from 560 to terminus	521 – from 558 west to terminus 505 – 1 mile from CR 4740 to terminus 503 – from property line south to terminus 567 – from private land to terminus
Ratcliff Lake - The 520 road around the lake is closed to all traffic. Forest visitors can access Dogwood and Lakeshore loops, but not the over flow area or Loblolly loop
