***ROAD RESTRICTION
Portion of NFS #594 Road System
For Public Safety***

PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following act is prohibited on the National Forest System roads described in this order, within the administrative boundaries of the Lowman Ranger District, Boise National Forest. This Order will be in effect upon signing and will remain in effect until **October 31, 2017**, unless rescinded earlier by the Forest Supervisor.

1. Using a motor vehicle on the roads as described below. **36 CFR 261.54(a)**

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local law enforcement officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this order is to provide for the protection of public health and safety due to hazards associated with the Pioneer Fire.

ROAD RESTRICTION DESCRIPTION

National Forest System (NFS) Road #594 (Rock Creek Road) is closed to all motor vehicles beginning at the junction of NFS Roads #551 and 594 located in Township 8 North, Range 7 East, Section 17, and traveling easterly, becoming northerly to the junction of NFS Road #594 and Idaho State Highway 21 (near Lowman, ID) located in Township 9 North, Range 7 East, Section 27, Boise Meridian.

NFS Roads #594E, #549D, #594D1, #594D2, and #594DA are closed to motor vehicles and are within the above identified #594 Road System.

The described roads as shown on the attached map, are within the Lowman Ranger District, Boise National Forest, Boise County, Idaho

IMPLEMENTATION

1. This Order will be in effect upon signing and will remain in effect until **October 31, 2017**, unless rescinded earlier by the Forest Supervisor.
2. A map identifying the above-described area is attached to and made part of this Order.
3. Any violation of this order is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six months [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].
4. This Order supersedes any previous orders/notices for the above-described roads or portions thereof.


