



FIRE RESTRICTIONS

ON THE DANIEL BOONE NATIONAL FOREST London Ranger District

NO OPEN FLAMES

Open fires are restricted except in sites with metal campfire rings and pedestal grills that were installed by the Forest Service. The use of portable lanterns, stoves, or heating equipment that utilize gas, petroleum or pressurized liquid fuel is allowed.



FIRE PERMITTED AREAS

You can have a fire in Forest Service metal fire rings and grills at these areas:

- Bee Rock Campground
- Rockcastle Campground
- S-Tree Campground & Picnic Shelter
- Turkey Foot Campground & Picnic Shelter
- Baldrock Picnic Area
- Laurel Bridge Picnic Area
- Flatwoods Picnic Area
