



ORDER 06-18-01-16-11

CLOSURE FOR PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY

**WILLAMETTE NATIONAL FOREST
McKenzie River Ranger District**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) the following acts are prohibited in the area described in this order within the administrative authority of the Willamette National Forest. This order will become effective upon signature, and will remain in effect until modified, rescinded or November, 2018.

PROHIBITION:

(1) Being in an area closed for public health or safety.

§36 CFR 261.53(e)

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR §261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- (1) Any person with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.**
- (2) Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of official duty.**
- (3) Persons engaged in a business, trade or occupation in the area.**

DESCRIPTION OF AREA CLOSED:

- All areas closed by this order are located within T14SR06ES36, T15SR06ES01, T15SR06ES02, T14SR06ES11
- The area closed is along the 2600-730 road from the junction of road 2600-730 with the McKenzie River Trail (Trail # 3507) to the crest of Smith Dam.
- Entry is prohibited from the eastern road edge to 50 feet east of the road edge and from the western road edge to 50 feet west of the west bank of Smith River in the Smith Bypass Reach.
