Permits are \$10 for up to a 20 foot tree.

**Cutting is only allowed on the Evanston-Mountain View RD.**

No tree cutting is allowed within a 2 mile radius of the junction of FS Road #058 (North Slope Road) and Highway 150.

No cutting is allowed in the Lily Lake Cross-Country Ski Area.

**A MIRROR LAKE RECREATION PASS IS NOT REQUIRED FOR CUTTING CHRISTMAS TREES**

The Forest Service is offering the public a family recreation experience. To help make it a more pleasant experience, please observe the following regulations:

- a) Individuals with permits are expected to cut their own tree.
- b) One permit per person/household, age 18 years old and up.
- c) Trees may be no more than 20 feet tall.
- d) Any species of tree may be cut. Lodgepole pine is the main species on the district.
- e) Sign and attach permit to tree before transporting tree.
- f) Tree stump should be cut flat and less than 8 inches in height from ground level.
- g) No cutting in campgrounds, trailheads, or administrative sites.
- h) Snowmobiling and snowplay are prohibited on plowed roads.
- i) No snowmobiling or cutting Christmas trees in the High Uintas Wilderness.
- j) Violations to the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache NF travel plan are not allowed.
- k) Tree topping is not allowed.
- l) Permits cannot be replaced or refunded.

Snow conditions on Highway 150 may require permit holders to have access to a snowmobile for removal of trees. Please check with the Ranger District for conditions.

**Permits are valid from November 10 thru December 25, 2016.**
