Tree Identification: Can you identify these key conifer trees found on the Chippewa National Forest?



A. These trees have ssssssss-scaley needles.



B. This tree has short, sharp square-shaped needles and a sharp scent.



C. This big pine is named for the color of its bark. (long needles in groups of 2)



D This beautiful pine tree has the same number of letters in its name as the number of needles it has in a cluster.

E. This scraggly pine has a man's name, but it is most known for benefitting from wildfire. Its cones open when exposed to fire. Short needles in groups of 2.



F. Needles on this tree are fresh and fragrant. This is a popular choice for Christmas trees on the Chippewa National Forest!
