

Notice to the Public DEC-JAN 2017

CAMP SHELBY LIVE FIRE AND TRAINING NOTICE TO PUBLIC. The Camp Shelby Joint Forces Training Center continually supports live fire training events throughout the year. In the support of safety, various gates and temporary barricades are emplaced during training events to protect the public. Through the months of December 2016 and January 2017, the following road are affected:

14-16 December 2016

Roads affected: 305I, 305K, 305K1, 367C, 311, 311B, 369B, 369D and 304/Davis Range Road

17-19 December 2016

Roads affected: 305I, 305K, 305K1, 367, 367C, 311 and 311B

3-29 January 2017

Roads affected: 305I, 305K, 305K1, 367C, 311, 311A1, 369, 369A, 369B, 369B1, 369D, 369E and 304/Davis Range Road

A bridging project is underway on the South Tank Trail which is causing the closure of that road. This project replaces two existing structures located along the South Tank Trail and is scheduled for completion March 2017.

202 East Air to Ground Range will also be operational throughout these months resulting in safety fan closures in that area.

In addition to live fire training, there will be maneuver training throughout the training areas and along public roads. Please be aware of troop movements during the day and night. Night operations may include Black Out driving which will include vehicles operating without lights on. Please be aware of this activity as you travel along the Camp Shelby area.

Unexploded ordnance (UXO) is always a danger at Camp Shelby. I ask that you do not access any off limits areas and do not cross any closed gates or barricades. The dangers of UXO are real. If you encounter a UXO follow the 3-Rs, Recognize-Retreat-Report. Recognize the danger. Retreat, following the same path. Report, contact Camp Shelby Range Control @ 601-558-2709 or call 911.
