FOREST ORDER NO. 06-03-03-16-05

ROAD CLOSURE
COUGAR CREEK SALVAGE PROJECT

Pursuant to 16 USC § 551 and 36 CFR § 261.50 (b), the following act is prohibited in the Cougar Creek Salvage Project Winter Road Closure Area on the Mt. Adams Ranger District within the Gifford Pinchot National Forest as described below and shown in Exhibit A. This Order will be effective beginning December 23, 2016 and ending May 1, 2017.

PROHIBITION:

1. Using any motorized vehicle within the Cougar Creek Salvage Project Winter Road Closure Area. 36 CFR § 261.54 (a).

COUGAR CREEK SALVAGE PROJECT WINTER ROAD CLOSURE AREA:

The closure area consists of the following Forest Roads and applies to all motorized vehicles, including snowmobiles.

- No. 82 from milepost 2.23 to 6.2 (the Forest Service boundary to Snow King Sno-Park)
- No. 8225-060 from milepost 2.06 to 2.4 (junction of the 8225-060/8225-071 to Road 82)
- No. 8225-150 from milepost 0.6 to 3.2 (the Snipes Mountain Trailhead to its end at the 8225-071 junction)
- No 8225-791 in its entirety (from its begin at the junction with 8225-150 until its end in section 18).

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a contract or permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 C.F.R. Part 261, Subpart A.


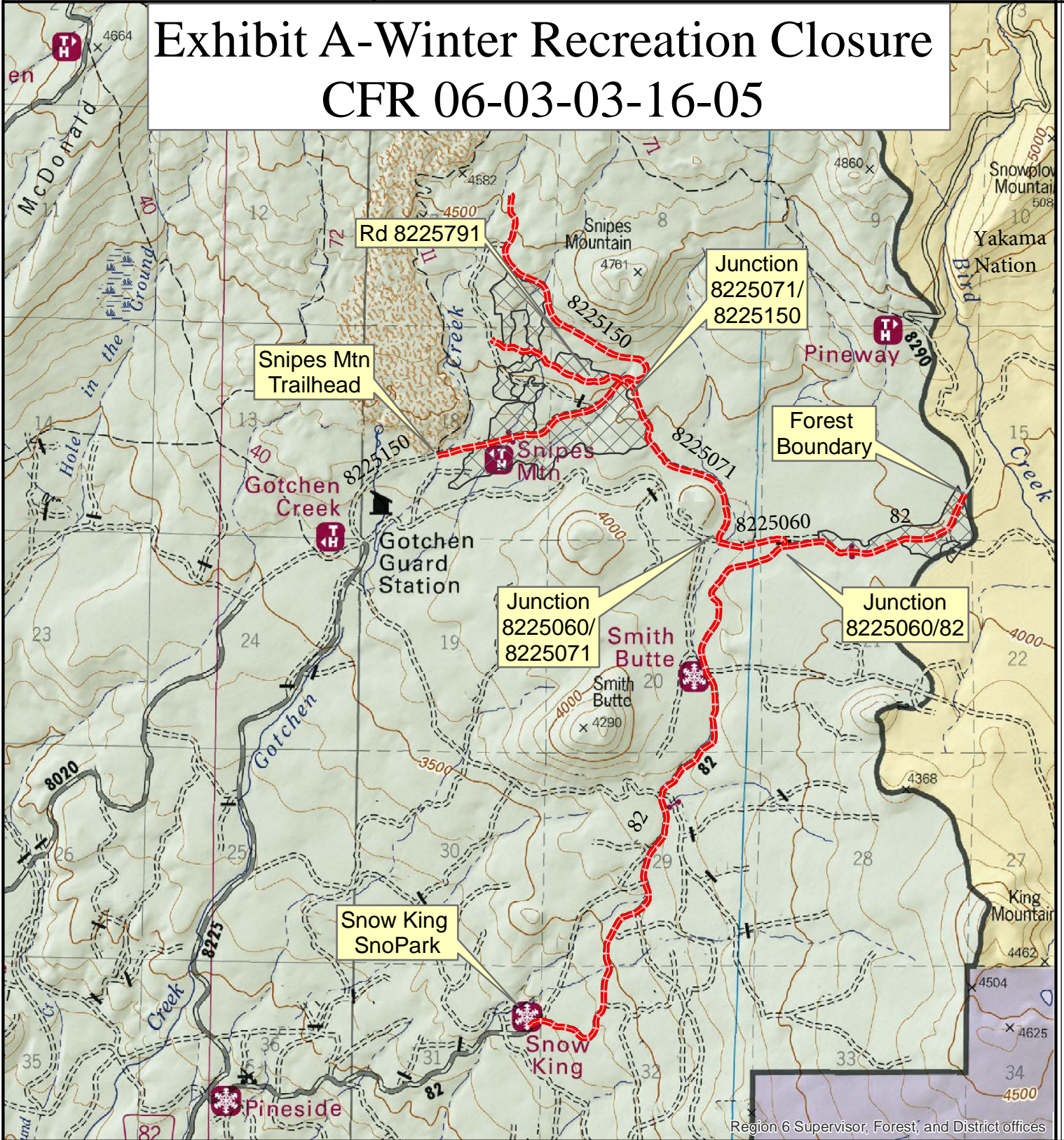
