PROHIBITIONS

FOREST SUPERVISOR ORDER NO. 08-13-08-17-01
LYNDON B. JOHNSON NATIONAL GRASSLANDS
UNITS 29 & 75

Pursuant to the provisions of 16 U.S.C., Section 551 and Title 36 C.F.R. 261.50(a) the following acts are prohibited within the Area Closed.

PROIBITED ACTS: Harassing, harming, pursuing, hunting, shooting, wounding, killing, trapping, capturing, or collecting of both wild and pen-raised quail or attempting to engage in such conduct. 36 CFR 261.58(v)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Person(s) conducting dog trials (e.g. the training of bird dogs) provided that no wild or pen-raised quail are harmed, hunted, shot, wounded, killed, trapped, captured, or collected.
2. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
3. Any Federal, State, or Local Law Enforcement Officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

AREA CLOSED: UNITS 29 & 75 of the LYNDON B JOHNSON GRASSLANDS located in Wise County, Texas and as shown on the attached map.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Closure Order is effective **February 8, 2017** and continues until **February 7, 2021** unless earlier rescinded.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.
