TEMPORARY TRAIL CLOSURE

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b) **the following act is prohibited** on the National Forest System trail described in this order. The trail affected in this order is located all within the Ogden Ranger District, Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest. This order is in effect Thursday, May 25, 2017 through November 31, 2017, or until portions of the trail damaged by flood waters can be repaired.

1. **Being in or upon the Pineview West trail** (Forest Service trail #612) as described below and shown on attached map. [36 CFR 261.53(e)]

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIBED:

Pineview West trail (Forest Service trail #612) from the North Arm trailhead south along the trail to the end of the boardwalk located in Township 7 North, Range 1 East, Sections 34 and 3 all within the Salt Lake Based Meridian as shown on the attached map.

PURPOSE:

Purpose of the Order is for public health and safety due to flooding, erosion and trail washouts.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect Thursday, May 25, 2017 through November 31, 2017, or until portions of the trail damaged by flood waters can be repaired.
2. Attached map shows the area affected by this Order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition(s) is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual, or \$10,000 for an organization and/or imprisonment for not more than 6 months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b) (6), Title 18 US3581(b) (7)].

5. This Order supersedes any previous Order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this Order in the areas (and/or roads or trails) covered by this Order.
