## AREA NOTICE



### Area and Trails Closed to Dogs

Dogs are prohibited in the following winter recreation areas: Dutchman Flat, Swampy Lakes, Meissner and Vista Butte trail Systems. Areas south of Cascade Lakes Hwy and in the Skyliner area are open to Dogs.

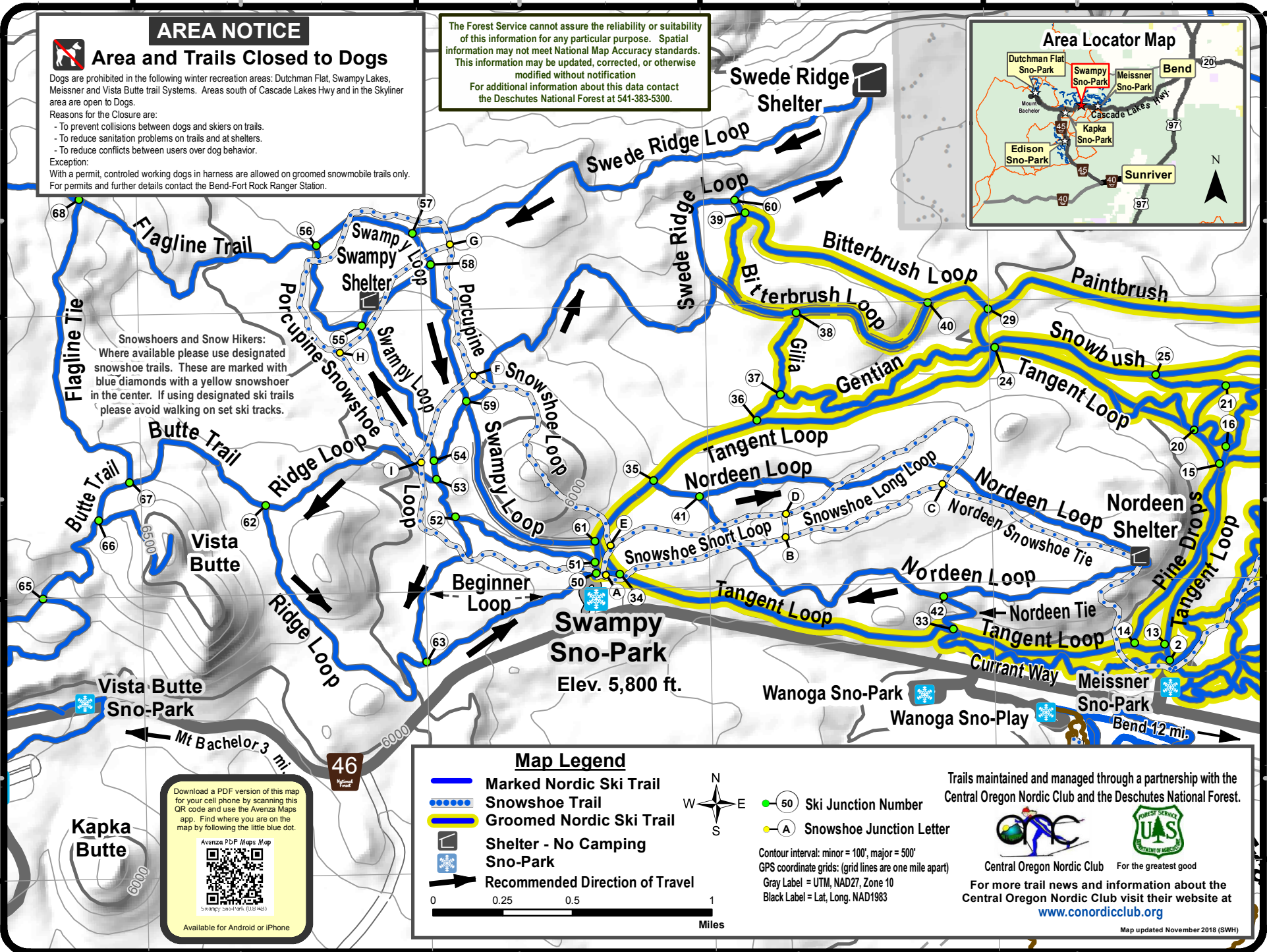
Reasons for the Closure are:

- To prevent collisions between dogs and skiers on trails.
- To reduce sanitation problems on trails and at shelters.
- To reduce conflicts between users over dog behavior.

Exception:

With a permit, controlled working dogs in harness are allowed on groomed snowmobile trails only. For permits and further details contact the Bend-Fort Rock Ranger Station.

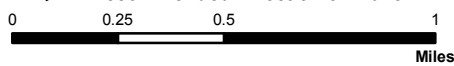
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**Snowshoers and Snow Hikers:**  
Where available please use designated snowshoe trails. These are marked with blue diamonds with a yellow snowshoer in the center. If using designated ski trails please avoid walking on set ski tracks.
