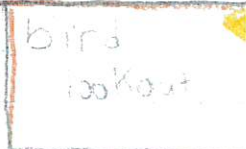

Thank you for reading this. I truly appreciate it. I hope you take my idea into consideration. I really would enjoy a scavenger hunt on this island. I think others would to.

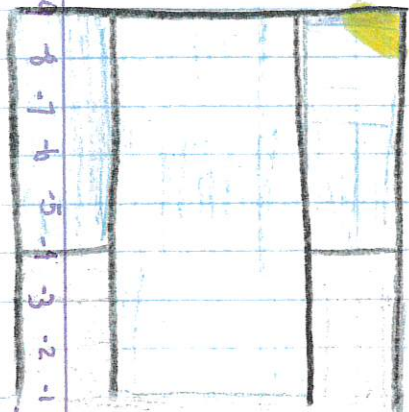

Parking lot

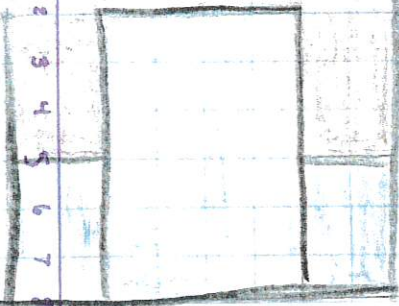
