

Appendix B ~ Road Maps for Alternative 2

The entire Tonto National Forest was divided into sections by a grid. The title page of the Alternative 2 Map Book shows the reference grid, which has 34 sections numbered 2 through 35. In the top right of the page, a Travel Management legend contains a color-coded key, explaining which NFS roads and trails are: 1) closed or decommissioned, 2) open to high clearance vehicles, 3) open to passenger vehicles, 4) unauthorized, 5) administrative use only by previous decision, and 6) are part of the existing Bulldog off highway vehicle permit zone. Each of the 34 sections of the reference grid has a corresponding one-page map in pdf form.


When a change from a road's current management level is proposed, the road is overlaid with a color that represents the proposed management level. These colored overlays are: Red) closed or decommissioned, Purple) open for motorized trails, Orange) open for high clearance vehicles, Brown) open for passenger vehicles, Blue) open for administrative use only and Yellow) seasonally restricted.

For example, on page 2, Forest Road 3157 is currently closed or decommissioned (as shown by the dotted black line) and is highlighted in orange. This means the closed road is proposed to be managed as open to high clearance vehicles.

In addition, the maps show proposed off highway vehicle areas and additional proposed off highway vehicle permit zones.
