This trip will be led by experienced Wilderness Inquiry Trail Guides and Forest Service staff. **All food, camping equipment, and round trip transportation from the Twin Cities will be provided.** Trips are provided free of charge through grant funding from the USDA Forest Service and financial aid provided by Wilderness Inquiry. The 12 spots will be filled on a first come, first served basis.
