Current Condition Overview: The Dillon Ranger District is currently open for recreation. Please use all FS land and trail heads responsibly and keep physical distance from other members of the public. The Dillon Ranger District is under Stage 1 Fire Restrictions.

Campgrounds: All developed campgrounds are set to close October 4th at 12 pm for the season.

Seasonal Advisory: The “summer” travel season ends November 21st, weather permitting. Some areas may close earlier than this date due to snow and muddy conditions or wildlife concerns. Please respect gate closures and find alternate routes.

Food Storage & Camping: Effective May 2019 – October 2023, visitors camping in developed sites or dispersed sites must store food in a bear-resistant container or inside locked vehicles. Trail Closures: 10/05 – 10/17: Wide Open and Scrapy trails will be closed Mon-Fri, roughly 6:30am-4:30pm, while helicopters are flying with suspended loads for decommissioning operations. Both the Wide Open and Scrapy trails will be open after 4:30pm on weekdays and all day on weekends. All *other* Tenderfoot Mountain trails will remain open.

North Fork Swan – FSR #354	OPEN: ATVs and unlicensed motorcycles allowed with permit. Snowmobiles permitted on designated routes. Both gates are open.
North Rock Creek – FSR #1350	OPEN: No ATVs or unlicensed vehicles.
Pennsylvania Creek – FSR #611	OPEN: Open to wheeled vehicles 5/21 to 11/22 when conditions allow. ATV's and unlicensed motorcycles allowed with permit.
Peru Creek – FSR #260	OPEN: Open to wheeled vehicles 5/21 to 11/22 when conditions allow. ATV's and unlicensed motorcycles allowed with permit.
Saints John – FSR #275	OPEN: Open to wheeled vehicles 5/21 to 11/22 when conditions allow. ATV's and unlicensed motorcycles allowed with permit. Snowmobiles on designated routes, see MVUM.
Santa Fe Peak – FSR #264	OPEN: Open to wheeled vehicles 5/21 to 11/22 when conditions allow. No ATV's or unlicensed vehicles.
Shrine Pass – FSR #16 / 709	OPEN: Scheduled to open June 21st if conditions allow. ATV's and unlicensed motorcycles allowed with permit.
Spring Creek Area FSR #1831/ 1832/ 1833 /1834/ 23	OPEN: ATVs and unlicensed motorcycles allowed with permit.
Spruce Creek – FSR #800 / 803	OPEN: No ATV's or unlicensed vehicles.
Straight Creek – FSR #51	OPEN: Open ONLY to ATVs or unlicensed motorcycles 62" or less in width from 5/21 to 11/22 when conditions allow.
Webster Pass – FSR #285	OPEN: Open to ATVs and unlicensed vehicles.
Williams Peak – FSR #200	OPEN: Open to ATV's and unlicensed motorcycles ONLY 6/15 to 11/15 when conditions allow.
