OCCUPANCY AND USE

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited in the **Open Pond Recreation Area, Conecuh Ranger District**, of the National Forests in Alabama. This closure order is effective **until rescinded by the Forest Supervisor**.

1. Camping within designated campground for a period of longer than 14 days between March 1 and September 30. **36 CFR 261.58 (a)** "For purposes of calculating the 14 day time period, the day a camper arrives at a camp site will be considered one (1) day regardless of the time of arrival."
2. Parking or leaving a vehicle in violation of a posted sign. **36 CFR 261.58(g)**
3. Parking or leaving a vehicle outside a parking space assigned to one's own camp unit.
36 CFR 261.58 (h)
4. Possessing, parking, or leaving more than two vehicles, except motorcycles or bicycles, per camp unit. **36 CFR 261.58 (i)**
5. Being in the area between 10p.m. and 6 a.m. except a person who is camping or who is visiting a person camping in that area is prohibited. **36 CFR 261.58 (u)**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this Order:

Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the General Prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Violation of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual and \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. Title 16 USC Section 551 and Title 18 USC 3559 and 3571.
