OCCUPANCY AND USE

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited in the **Coleman Lake, Pine Glenn, Warden Horse Camp, Shoal Creek Ranger District**, of the National Forests in Alabama. This closure order is effective **until rescinded by the Forest Supervisor**.

The following acts are **PROHIBITED** as set forth in 36 CFR 261.58.

1. Camping for a period longer than 14 days is prohibited. **36 CFR 261.58 (a)**
2. Parking or leaving a vehicle outside a parking space assigned to one's own camp unit is prohibited. **36 CFR 261.58 (h)**
3. Being in the area between 10p.m. and 6 a.m. except a person who is camping or who is visiting a person camping in that area is prohibited. **36 CFR 261.58 (u)**
4. Possessing, parking, or leaving more than two vehicles, except motorcycles or bicycles, per camp unit. **36 CFR 261.58 (i)**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in performance of any official duty.
