CAMPING NOTES

Some campgrounds are accessible. Please don't use sites that are still wet so no resource damage occurs.

Please note that because of the pine beetle problem, please look up and around before deciding on a spot to camp. Campgrounds that are accessible will be cleared of obvious hazards trees when crews arrive in late May, but strongs winds have toppled both dead and live trees on the district.

The Lily Lake dump and water station is closed.

RECREATION RESERVATIONS

The National Recreation Reservation Service takes reservations for most campgrounds up to 180 days in advance at **1-877-444-6777** or on the Internet at <u>www.recreation.gov</u>. These sites can be reserved no less than 5 days in advance. Reservations are for June 18 to September 6 only.

Bear River Ranger Station: Will be open with window service only starting Friday, May 28 – May 31. Hours/days will be limited to start the season. More scheduling information will be coming soon.
