FOREST ORDER  
PUBLIC USE FIRE RESTRICTIONS

Pursuant to 16 USC §551 and 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited in the areas described in this order within the administrative boundaries of the Willamette National Forest. This order will become effective August 4, 2017, 12:01 AM and will remain in effect until rescinded, or November 15, 2017.

**PROHIBITION:**

1. Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.52, building, maintaining, attending or using a fire, campfire, or stove fire (a) except in the following situations:
  - Using pressurized liquid or gas-fueled stoves or lanterns.
  - Using provided metal campfire rings within the developed recreational sites listed in Exhibit A.Definitions: ***Campfire*** means a fire, not within any building, mobile home or living accommodation mounted on a motor vehicle, which is used for cooking, personal warmth, lighting, ceremonial or esthetic purposes. ***Stove Fire*** means a campfire built inside an enclosed stove or grill, or a portable brazier, including wood or charcoal.
2. Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.52(c), smoking except in the following situations:
  - Within an enclosed vehicle
  - Within the developed recreational sites listed in Exhibit A.
3. Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.52 (i), welding, or operating an acetylene or other torch with open flame
4. Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.52 (h), operating an internal combustion engine except in the following situations:
  - i. Motor vehicles on the roadways, trails and areas as designated by the Willamette National Forest Motor Vehicle Use Map.
  - ii. Boat motors in water or motors used on the water for dredge operations
  - iii. Generators in developed recreational sites listed in Exhibit A.

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR§ 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- (1) Any person with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission;
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Violations of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual or \$10,000.00 for a corporation or imprisonment for not more than six months or both. Title 16 USC Section 551.

Building, maintaining, attending, or using a fire, campfire or stove fires is authorized in provided metal campfire rings or grills in the following developed recreational sites, except when the campground is closed:
