TIBBLE FORK AREA/TRAIL CLOSURE

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b) **the following acts are prohibited** in the National Forest System area and trail as described in this order. All lands affected are located on the Pleasant Grove Ranger District, Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest. This order is in effect from August 8, 2017 through August 19, 2017

1. **Being in or upon the area including the Tibble Fork trail** (Forest Service trail #041) as described below and as shown on attached map. This includes all uses. [36 CFR 261.53(e)]

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIBED:

The area south of Tibble Fork Reservoir will be closed from the water's edge to the ridge line including the fisherman's access trail and the area between the Mill Canyon trail (Forest Service trail #040) and Tibble Fork trail (Forest Service trail #041). The closure also includes the Tibble Fork trail (Forest Service trail #041) from the Tibble Fork Reservoir dam south to the junction with the Mud Springs trail (Forest Service trail #173) as shown on attached map, located in Township 4 South, Range 3 East, Sections 7, 8, and 17 all within the Salt Lake Base Meridian, as shown on map.


PURPOSE:

Purpose of the Closure is to provide for health and public safety while construction crews and heavy equipment are re-routing the Tibble Fork trail.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed August 8, 2017 and shall remain in effect through August 19, 2017 or until rescinded.
2. Attached map shows the areas affected by this Order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition(s) is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization and/or imprisonment for not more than 6months imprisonment. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b) (6), Title 18 USC 3581(b) (7)].
