

**FOREST ORDER
USE RESTRICTION**

NFSR 114.1 (Middle St. Vrain), 507.1, 507.1A, 507.1B, 507.1C, and 507.1D (Coney Flats)

Roosevelt National Forest
Boulder Ranger District

Pursuant to 16 United States Code (U.S.C.) § 551 and 36 Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.) §§ 261.50 (a) and (b), 261.54 (a) the following acts are prohibited on National Forest System Roads NFSR 114.1 (Middle St. Vrain), 507.1, 507.1A, 507.1B, 507.1C, and 507.1D (Coney Flats), on the Boulder Ranger District of the Roosevelt National Forest, in Boulder County, Colorado (hereinafter known as the Restricted Roads). The Restricted Roads are depicted and shown on the attached map hereby incorporated into this order as Exhibit A and a Motor Vehicle as defined in Exhibit B.

The purpose of this Order is to help protect public health and safety due to emergency road repair activity.

PROHIBITIONS:

- Operating a Motor Vehicle on a Restricted Road. 36 C.F.R. § 261.54(a)


EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1) Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty;
- 2) Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

This Order shall be in effect starting 12:01a.m. on August 18, 2017 and will remain in effect until 11:59 p.m. on August 28, 2017.

Violations of these prohibitions are punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C §§ 3559 and 3571).
