

ORDER NO. 10-17-07
EMERGENCY CLOSURE
SIX RIVERS NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 16 USC and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited on the Gasquet Ranger District, Smith River National Recreation Area of the Six Rivers National Forest. This Order is effective from August 18, 2017, until the Young's Fire is declared out.

1. Being on the National Forest System trails listed below as shown on the attached map.
 - a. Forest Trail No. 4E04 (Doe Flat Trail), from the Doe Flat Trailhead then continuing easterly to its intersection with the Forest boundary.
 - b. Forest Trail No. 5E02 (Young's Valley Trail), from the Young's Valley Trailhead then continuing easterly to its intersection with the Forest boundary.

36 CFR 261.55(a).

2. Entering or using the Developed Recreation Sites listed below as shown on the attached map.
 - a. Doe Flat Trailhead.
 - b. Young's Valley Trailhead.

36 CFR 261.58(b).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both.

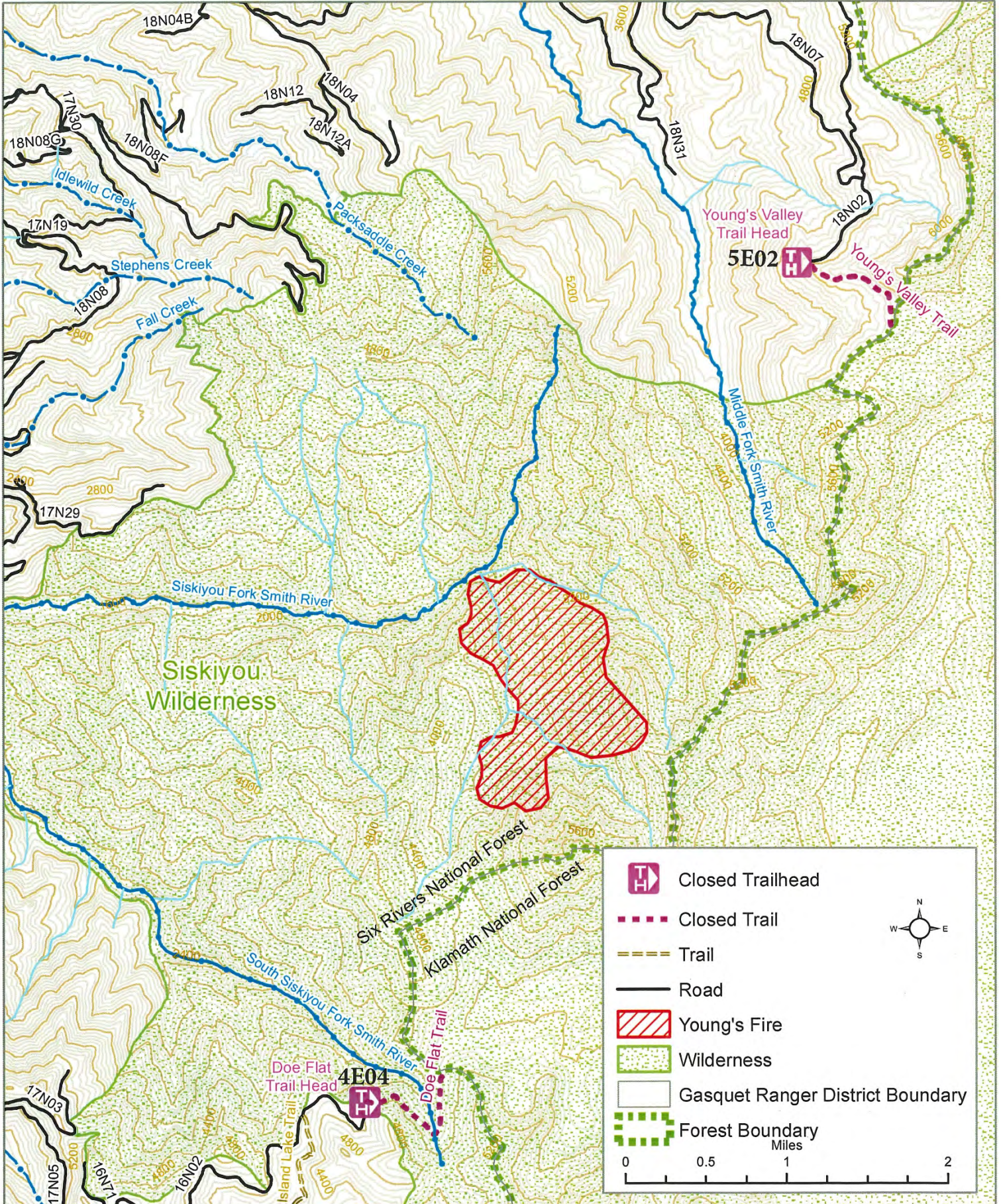
