Logan Ranger District Fire Restrictions

Fires are currently permitted on National Forest lands within the Logan Ranger District with the following exceptions:

- No fireworks or exploding targets are permitted on National Forest lands.
- Fires are prohibited outside of the campground fire rings in the Tony Grove Basin.
- Fires are prohibited on the face between Green Canyon road and Logan Canyon (Highway 89).

Active fire restrictions for unincorporated private lands in parts of Rich, Cache, Box Elder and Morgan Counties.

Logan Cave:

The cave is gated and closed. The cave was closed to the public on October 1, 1997 to ensure the viability of a rare and special biological community of Townsend's Big-Eared Bats that is located in Logan Cave. The bats are particularly vulnerable to human disturbance during their periods of mating, hibernation, and maternity colony, which runs from about October to August each year. The Big-Eared Bat is listed as a sensitive species by both the Forest Service and Utah Division of Wildlife Resources. To aid with protecting this species during their vulnerable period, it is prohibited to go into or within 250 feet of the mouth of the Logan Cave.

Guard Station:

The Blacksmith Fork Guard Station is available to rent year round. Reservations can be made by contacting the National Recreation Reservation System (NRRS) by calling 877-444-6777 or visit the website at www.recreation.gov.

Developed Area Uses:

In our developed areas (i.e. campgrounds, picnic areas, and trailheads), campfires are only permitted in Forest Service constructed permanent cement, metal fire rings, or grills.

Firewood Permits:

The Logan Ranger District is offering firewood cutting permits this year. Permits are valid for dead and down wood, in designated areas. Please stop in the office to purchase a permit or call 435-755-3620 for more information.

Pallet Closure:

The pallet closure prohibits any firewood material containing nails, screws, or other metal hardware on the forest.

Dispersed Camping:

Visitors may camp for up to 14 days in any 30 day consecutive period in areas designated for dispersed camping.

Bear Lake Overlook:

Located 32 miles from the mouth of Logan Canyon and 5 miles west of Garden City. It serves as the east portal to the Logan Canyon National Scenic Byway. An information booth is located inside the building and staffed by the Bear Lake Convention & Visitors Bureau. Visit the website www.bearlake.org.

Stokes Nature Center:

Hardware Ranch:
