

Plumas National Forest Mail-in Christmas Tree Permit Request

Christmas trees may be cut from November 1st to December 24th although ice and snow may close roads at any time. Those who are at least 18 years old may purchase a permit; they are non-refundable and no more than two permits will be sold to one address or household. Christmas tree cutting permits are \$10 per tree, and may be purchased directly from local forest service offices or through the mail-in request.

Mail-in requests may be submitted after October 1st but must be received by December 1st. Mail requests received after December 1st will be returned as the Forest Service will not guarantee that permits will reach their destination prior to December 24th. *No more than two permits will be mailed to one address or household.*
