Dear Interested Forest User:

The Apache-Sitgreaves National Forests began implementing their revised Land Management Plan (LMP) on October 25, 2015, under the provisions of the U. S. Forest Service's 1982 Planning Rule. The forests have now re-initiated the planning process to implement the Forest Service's Travel Management Rule (36 CFR 212), which had been suspended after the 2011 Wallow Fire. I determined that certain travel-related definitions in the 2015 Land Management Plan needed to be changed to conform to definitions provided in the Travel Management Rule. Administrative Change #4 accomplishes that purpose.

This letter is to document my approval of Administrative Change #4.

Approval of Administrative Change

This Administrative Change is a modification of the Apache-Sitgreaves National Forests' Land Management Plan for the Apache-Sitgreaves National Forests. We made changes to Other Content in Chapter 4 (Suitability) and in the Glossary, as provided for in 36 CFR 219.13(c).
