**OCCUPANCY AND USE**

MT. BAKER-SNOQUALMIE NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited within all developed recreation sites within the Mt. Baker-Snoqualmie National Forest, until further notice.

1. Entering or remaining in a campground between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. except for persons who are occupying such campgrounds. 36 CFR 261.58 (c).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This order supersedes order number 06-05-20-95-004.
