**TEMPORARY ROAD, TRAIL AND AREA CLOSURE - CHETCO BAR FIRE**

Pursuant to 16 USC § 551 and 36 CFR § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited upon Gold Beach Ranger District within the Rogue River-Siskiyou National Forest as described below and shown in Exhibit A. This Order will replace order number 06-10-26-18-46 and be effective beginning December 08, 2017 until superseded or rescinded.

**PROHIBITION:**

- 1) **Going onto or being within an area closed for public health and safety. [36 CFR § 261.53(e)]**

**TEMPORARY AREA CLOSURE DESCRIPTION:**

The Temporary Chetco Bar Fire Area Closure is bounded as follows, clockwise from Upper Chetco River Road (FSR 1376) at Steel Bridge: From Upper Chetco River Road at the north end of Steel Bridge, west along the Chetco River to Mineral Hill Fork, then north along Mineral Hill Fork to Upper Chetco River Road and Snowcamp Trail (FST 1103) junction. Northwest along Upper Chetco River Road to FSR 1407 junction, then southeast along Mislatah Creek to the Chetco River. East along the Chetco River to the Kalmiopsis Wilderness boundary. South along the Kalmiopsis Wilderness boundary to the South Fork Chetco River, then west to FSR 1107 at FSR 1107-520 junction. West along FSR 1107 to FSR 1107-570 junction, then north along FSRs 1107-570 and 1107-572 to the Forest boundary. North along the Forest boundary to Long Ridge/Packers Cabin (FSR 1917), then north to meet Upper Chetco River Road at the north end of Steel Bridge. Also closed are Mt Emily Road (FSR 1983) between FSRs 1983-030 and 1983-140, and the entirety of FSR 1983-110.

**ROADS CLOSED**

1. **Being on the following roads closed for public health and safety. [36 CFR § 261.54(e)]**
  - A. Mount Emily Road (FSR1983) between FSRs 1983-030 and 1983-140.
  - B. The entirety of FSR1983-110.
  - C. The following spur roads of Snaketooth (FSR 1107): 540, 550, 551, 553, 554, 555, 556, 557, 570, 571, 572, 573, 574, 577, and 950.
  - D. Vulcan Lake Road (FSR 1909 and all tributary roads east of the Forest boundary.
  - E. Long Ridge/Packers Cabin (FSR 1917) and all tributary roads east of the Forest Boundary.
  - F. FSR 1376 and all tributary roads between Steel Bridge and FSR1407 junction.

**RECREATION SITES CLOSED**

1. **Going onto or being within an area closed for public health and safety. [36 CFR § 261.53(e)].**
  - A. Little Redwood Campground
  - B. Packers Cabin

C. All trails within the closure area are closed.

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission. Persons seeking permit for entry need to request this from the Gold Beach District Ranger
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 C.F.R. Part 261, Subpart A.



Violations of this prohibition is punishable as a Class B Misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both (16 USC § 551; 18 USC § 3559 and 18USC § 3571).


