SPECIAL ORDER OF FOREST SUPERVISOR
WASATCH-CACHE NATIONAL FOREST
SALT LAKE RANGER DISTRICT


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following act is prohibited on all areas described below and as shown on the map. All lands affected are located on the Salt Lake Ranger District, Wasatch-Cache National Forest. This order is in effect until further notice.

1. Discharging a firearm. [36 CFR 261.58 (m)]

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following acts, or persons, are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit or contract authorizing the otherwise prohibited act.
2. Authorized Federal, state, or local officers, or members of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of official duty, when authorized by the District Ranger.
3. Any person discharging a firearm within the boundaries of an approved public/private shooting range.
4. Any properly licensed person discharging a firearm in conjunction with legal hunting activities as provided by Utah State Code, wildlife rules or proclamations established by the Utah Wildlife board.

Area Described: All National Forest Lands along the Wasatch Front foothills located between Ward Canyon Road and Farmington Canyon Road below 5100 feet elevation (approximately the "high water" mark or "bench" for the Lake Bonneville Shoreline) as shown on the attached map.

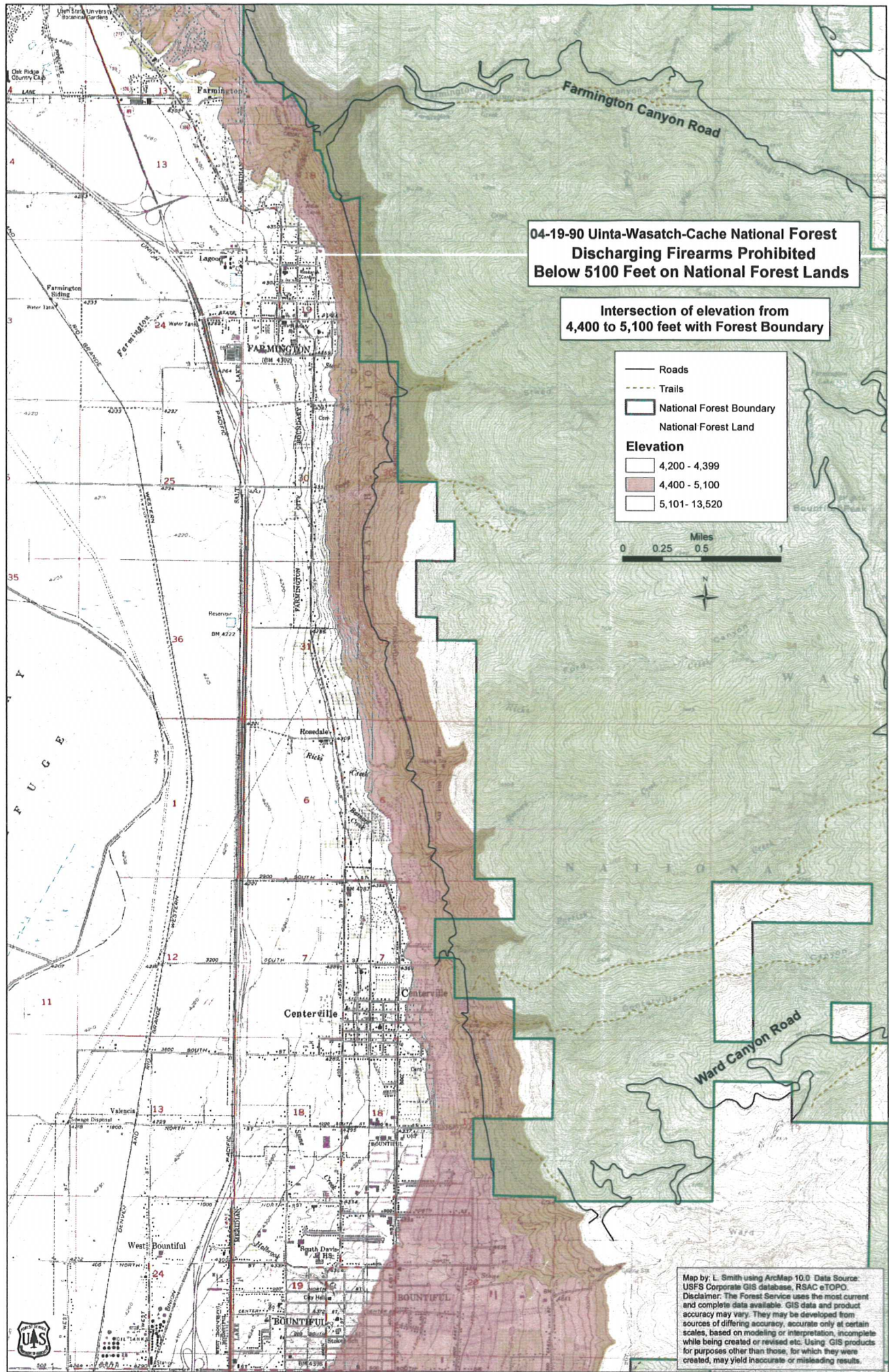

This order supersedes any previous orders/notices for the above described areas, and same said violation(s).

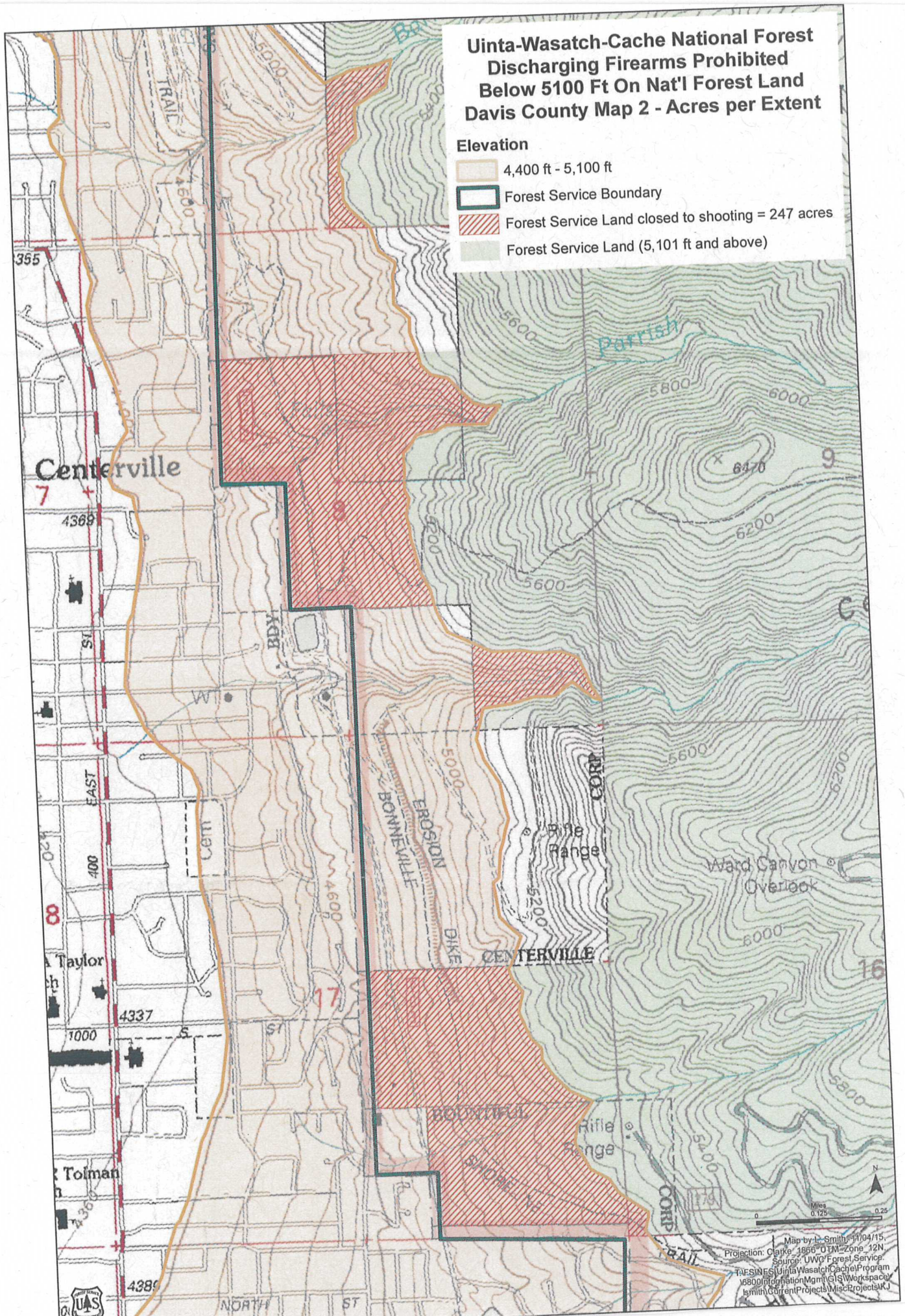

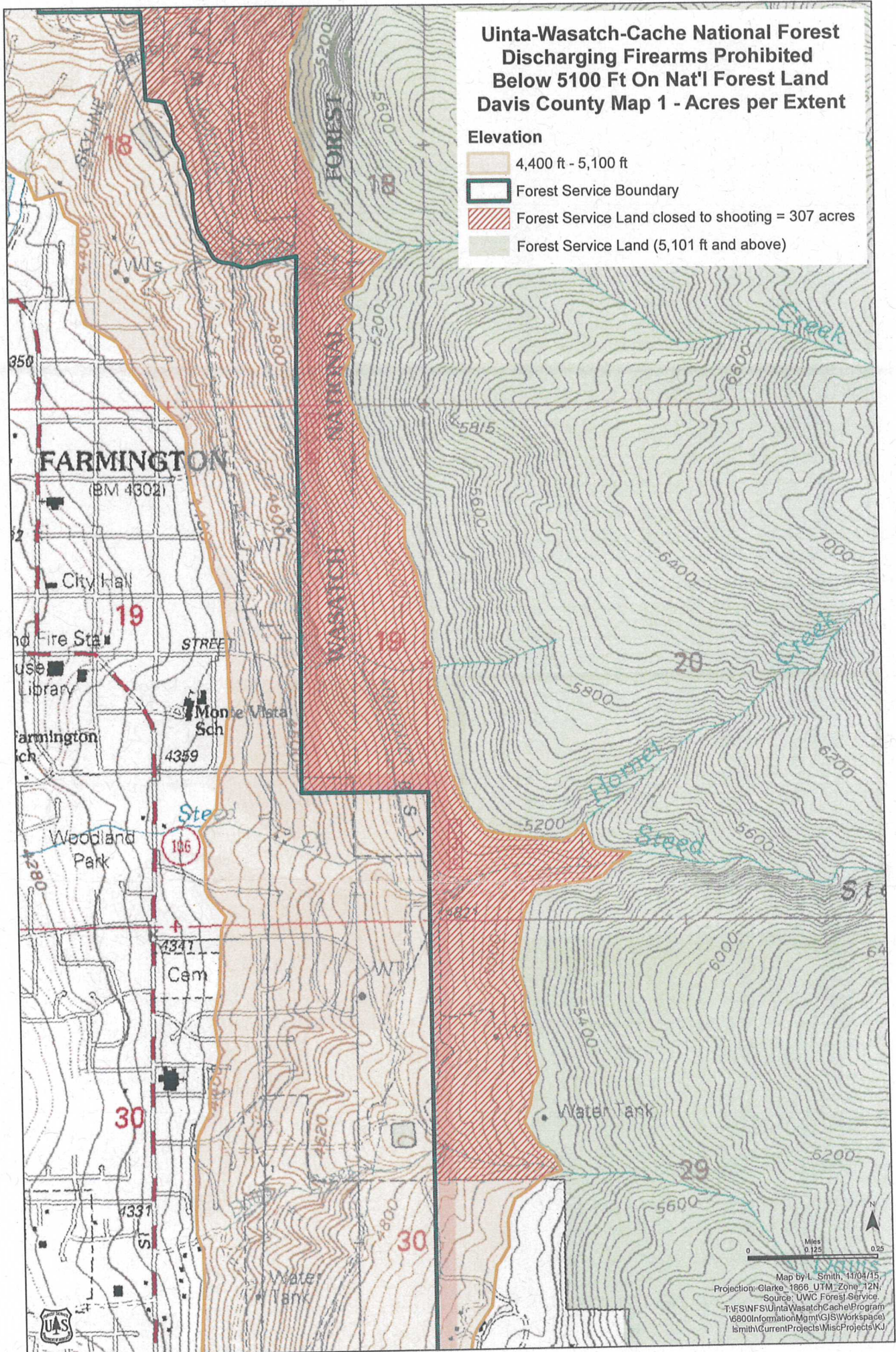

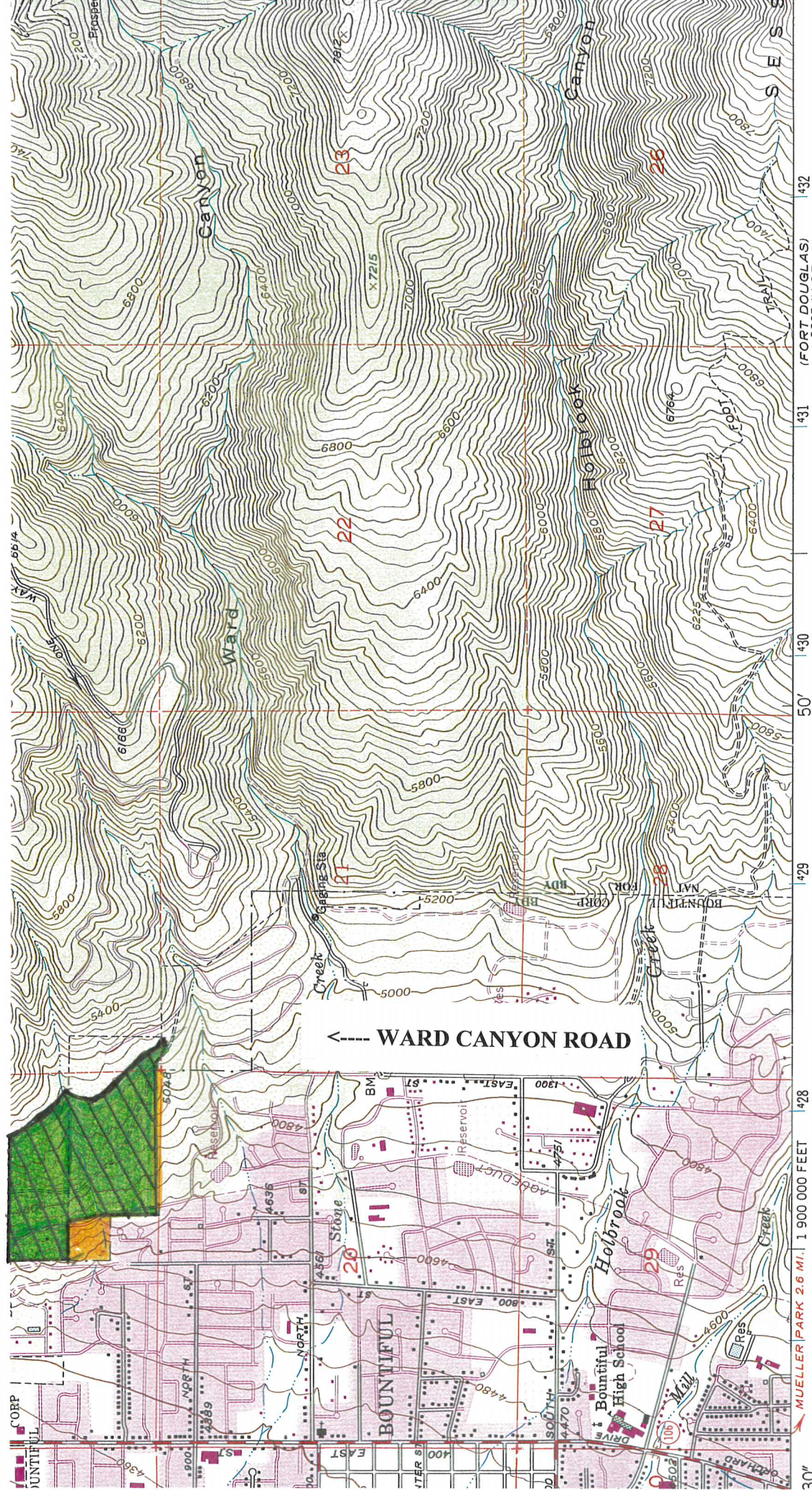
