Emergency Closure of Dispersed Campsites A5, A7 and A9.


Pursuant to the provisions of 16 U.S.C Section 551 and Title 36 C.F.R Sections 261.50 (a) and (b), for the protection of public health and safety, the following act is prohibited due to public safety concerns with logging operations at dispersed campsites A5, A7 and A9. This order is in effect from March 19, 2018 until June 19, 2018.

For public health and safety, it is prohibited to camp or establish a campsite at dispersed campsites A5, A7 and A9 in Graham County, 36 CFR 261.58 (e).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempted from this order:

1. Persons with a special use permit or contract specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
