

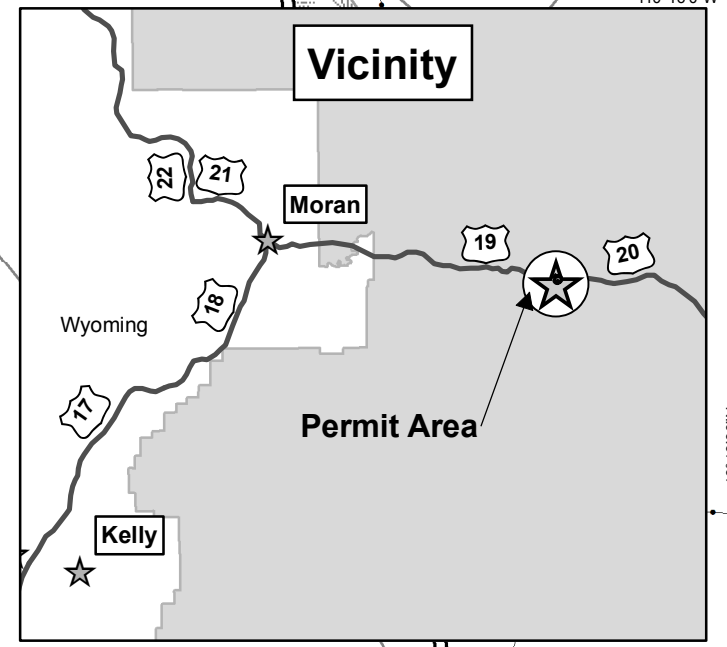
Four Mile Post & Pole Permit Area Map

Permit Conditions

- Trees authorized for removal range between 3 and 6.9 inches diameter at breast height (DBH).
- All trees marked with orange paint (trees greater than 6.9 inches DBH) are not authorized for removal.
- All stumps will be cut to 8 inches or less off the ground.
- Gathering of posts and poles will not impact the use of roads by other travelers. Roads will be kept clear of logs and debris.
- Use of heavy equipment (such as backhoes, wheeled or tracked crawler s, tree spades, etc.) for collecting forest products are not authorized unless specified in remarks section of the attached permit and signed by a designated forest officer.
- The use of motorized equipment (such as a winch, 2 or 4 wheel drive vehicle, ATV/ UTV's, etc.) is allowed to skid, deck, and haul products within 300 feet of roads provided there is NO resource damage (damage to residual vegetation, rutting, etc.). All motorized vehicles must follow the Bridger Teton motorized vehicle use map (MVUM).
- Access to the post and pole permit area is not permitted from US Highway 26. All access must come from Forest Roads 60050/60060/60061 Rosie's Ridge.
