PUBLIC SAFETY CLOSURE

Pursuant to 16 USC § 551 and 36 CFR § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following act is prohibited within the Walton Lake Campground Closure Area on the Lookout Mountain Ranger District of the Ochoco National Forest as described below and shown on the attached map (Exhibit A). This Order is effective beginning May 15, 2018 and ending May 15, 2020 unless rescinded.

Prohibitions

1. **Going into or being upon the Walton Lake Campground Closure Area.**
[36 CFR 261.53 (e)]

Walton Lake Campground Closure Area Description:

The Walton Lake Campground Closure Area encompasses an area beginning at the junction with National Forest System Road (NFS) No. 2220 to the terminus of the first loop at the first intersection; then east on NFS Road No. 2220 until the laminated root disease boundary; then east to the developed recreation boundary of Walton Lake Campground; then south to NFS Road No. 22200. The Walton Lake Campground Closure Area includes a 0.3 mile segment of Walton Lake Trail No. 809 beginning at the junction with NFS Road No. 2220 south to the developed recreation boundary of Walton Lake Campground. The geographic area of this closure as shown in Exhibit A is the NW ¼ Section 22 T13S R20E and will be signed and marked with pink flagging along all boundaries on the ground.

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Violations of this prohibition is punishable as a Class B Misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both (16 USC § 551; 18 USC § 3559 and 18 USC § 3571).
