



CAMPGROUND RULES

OHV USE - Prohibited

- This includes non-street legal ATVs, dirt bikes, and side-by-sides.
- Refer to the current Motor Vehicle Use Map for open roads.

CAMPSITE OCCUPANCY – Must Be Occupied First Night

- Cannot be left unoccupied for more than 24 hours.
- Maximum length of stay is 14 days.

FIRES - Don't Leave Fires Unattended - Extinguish Fully

- Fires should be no bigger than fire ring allows.
- No campfires outside of established fire rings.
- Be aware of any Public Use Restrictions in place.
- Use of fireworks and other explosives is prohibited.

DISCHARGING A FIREARM - Is Not Permitted

- This includes air soft guns, BB guns, bows and sling shots.

GARBAGE - Dispose of Garbage Properly

- No garbage in fire rings.
- Pack it in, pack it out. Leave No Trace!

NOISE - Keep Noise Levels Reasonable 24 hours a Day

- Noise and music should not be audible outside your campsite.
- Quiet hours are from 10pm to 6am.

SPEED - Speed Limit is 10 MPH

- Be aware of kids and pets.
- Drive carefully and watch your speed.

DOGS - Keep Dogs on a Leash - No Longer Than 6 Feet

- Do not leave pets unattended and keep them under control.
- Please pick up after your pet.
