PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) the following acts are prohibited on all National Forest System lands within the Santa Fe National Forest, in the State of New Mexico, within Rio Arriba, Los Alamos, Sandoval, Santa Fe, San Miguel, and Mora Counties, within the state of New Mexico (the "restricted area").

1. Possessing, storing, or transporting marijuana – (*Cannabis sativa L.* as defined by 21 USC 802.) **36 CFR 261.58(t)**

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

IMPLEMENTATION

1. This Order will be in effect from the date signed, and shall remain in effect until December 31, 2023.
2. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for individuals and \$10,000.00 for organizations, or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. [18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581]
3. This Order supersedes, rescinds, and replaces any previous orders prohibiting the same acts covered by the Order.
