**Order No. 01-04-01-18-002**

**ORDER**

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 261.58(e) the following acts are prohibited on designated portions of National Forest Service lands, roads, and trails described in this order as shown on the attached map, within the Coeur d'Alene River Ranger District of the Idaho Panhandle National Forests. These restrictions, which are in addition to those general prohibitions in Title 36 CFR, Part 261, Subpart A, become effective **June 6, 2018**, and will remain in effect until rescinded.

Type of closure:

1. Camping. [Title 36 CFR 261.58(e)].
2. Parking or leaving a vehicle in violation of posted instructions. [Title 36 CFR 261.58(g)].
3. When provided by an order, it is prohibited to go into or be upon an area which is closed for the protection of: Public health and safety [Title 36 CFR 261.53(e)].

Description:

**Camping in Kit Price Campground administrative site, located in T51N, R4E, Section 30, or parking a vehicle outside the campground gate that would block access for administrative purposes. This closure is necessary for the public health and safety due to hazardous trees in the campground.**

**EXEMPTIONS**

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt:

1. Persons with specific written authorization for the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official emergency duty. Report all emergency access to the Coeur d'Alene District Ranger as soon as possible.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.
4. Contractor and his personnel in the performance of their duties.

**RATIONALE:** The above emergency restriction are necessary for **PUBLIC HEALTH and SAFETY** due to hazardous trees within the campground.

**PENALTY:** Violation of this order is prohibited by provisions of the regulations cited, and under 7 USC 1011(0), 16 USC 551, and 18 USC 3571(b)(6). Any violation is subject to punishment by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both.

**NOTIFICATION:** A copy of this order shall be posted in the Forest Supervisor's Office, each District Ranger's office and other appropriate locations as prescribed under Title 36 CFR 261.51.
