Two Moose Prescribed Fire Project, Tofte Ranger District

Date Issued: June 3, 2018

Anticipated Implementation: Spring, Summer, or Fall Season

Location and Sizes: Township 60 North, Range 6 West, Section 8. The 108.5-acre unit is approximately 6 miles north of the Harriet Lake subdivision and less than 1 mile north of Two Moose Trail, along Lake County Rd. 705 near the intersection with Forest Road 369. One unit totaling 108.5 acres will be burned.

Purpose: Reduce hazardous fuels by removing heavy concentrations of dead and down surface fuels. Utilize prescribed fire to reduce post-harvest slash and prepare the site for planting or seed regeneration. Restore the ecological process of fire to the site by returning low-intensity surface fire at more natural intervals to maintain forest health.

Closure Information: Smoke warning signs will be placed along Lake County Road 705 and on Forest Road 369. No closures are anticipated, but expect traffic delays during burn operations on Lake County Road 705.
