CIBOLA NATIONAL FOREST AND NATIONAL GRASSLANDS SANDIA RANGER DISTRICT

STAGE III FOREST CLOSURE

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a), the following acts are prohibited on all National Forest System lands within the Cibola National Forest as described below in the following counties: Bernalillo and Sandoval County, within the State of New Mexico. The "Restricted Area" is described below, and depicted on the attached maps, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A and B.

PROHIBITIONS

1. Going into or being upon the Restricted Area. 36 CFR § 261.52(e)

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
- 2. Any Federal, State, or Local Officer, or member of an organized firefighting force or other forest service personnel in the performance of an official duty as approved by the District Ranger.
- 3. Residents using roads in the Restricted Area to the extent necessary to access their private property.

RESTRICTED AREA

The Restricted Area includes all National Forest System lands, roads and trails within the boundary of the Cibola National Forest and National Grasslands, Sandia Ranger District, except areas listed specifically below as "Open".

The entire district is closed, except for the following areas, trails, and roads:

OPEN Areas:

- Sandia Peak Tram and associated facilities. Visitors are not allowed to access any National
 Forest lands at the top of the Tram. Visitation will be confined to use of the Tram facilities and
 observation deck only.
- The Tijeras Pueblo Museum and interpretive trail located at the Sandia Ranger Station. Visitors must stay on the official trail.

o OPEN Trails:

Those portions of Forest Trail 365, including secondary trails associated with Forest Trail 365, outside of the Sandia Mountain Wilderness, and South of the Tram.

• OPEN Roads:

- Forest Road 242
- Forest Road 413

PURPOSE

This Order is necessary to protect public health and safety due to extreme fire danger.

IMPLEMENTATION

- 1. This Order will be in effect at 8:00 a.m. on Friday, June 15, 2018, and shall remain in effect until December 31, 2018, or until rescinded, whichever event occurs first.
- 2. Violation of these prohibitions in this Order is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months or both; 16 USC§ 551, and 18 USC§§ 3559 and 3571.
- 3. All existing Stage II Restrictions order number: 03-0655 will remain in effect.
