

ORDER NO. 08-18-10
MENDOCINO NATIONAL FOREST
YOLLA-BOLLY, YUKI, SNOW MOUNTAIN, and SANHEDRIN WILDERNESS AREAS

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a), and to protect natural resources, the following act is prohibited within the Mendocino National Forest. This Order is effective from June 27, 2018 through June 26, 2020.

Entering or being in the Yolla-Bolly, Yuki, Snow Mountain, or Sanhedrin Wilderness areas as part of a group that includes more than 25 persons. 36 CFR 261.58(f).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from the Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local Officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibition in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551, 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581.
