SPECIAL ORDER

Sugarloaf Fire

Pursuant to Title 16 U.S.C. § 551, and Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on National Forest System land, trails and roads described below, located in the vicinity of the Sugarloaf Fire.

PROHIBITIONS:

Being in the areas described below. 36 CFR 261.52(e).

Being on the Roads described below. 36 CFR 261.54(e).

Being on the Trails described below. 36 CFR 261.55(a).

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty;
2. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.

AREAS, ROADS, AND TRAILS DESCRIBED:

National Forest System Roads: 132, 136, 136.1A, 138, 138.1B, 138.1C, 138.1F, 138.1G, 138.2, 138.2A, 138.2B, 139, 139.2A, 140, 140.3, 141.1, 142.1, 144.1, 155, 160, 160.2B, 164, 879.1, 882, and 882.3.

National Forest System Trails: 12 (Byer's Peak), 13 (Mount Nystrom), 14 (St. Louis Lake), 14.1 (St. Louis Pass), 15 (Lake Evelyn), 16 (Bottle Pass), 16.1 (Bottle Peak), 17 (St. Louis Divide), 17.1 (B&B), 18 (Darling Creek), 19 (Keyser Ridge), 22 (Kinney Creek), 23 (Horseshoe Lake), 21 (South Fork), 21.1 (South Fork Spur), 24 (Ute Peak), 31 (Ute Pass), 35 (Ptarmigan Pass), 62 (Williams Fork Boardwalk), 96 (Jones Pass), 140 (Keyser Ridge Loop), 141 (Elk Wallow), 142 (K&K Connection), 145 (Richey Creek), and 146 (No See-Um).

Trailheads: South Fork Trailhead, Boardwalk Trailhead, Ute Peak Trailhead, Ute Pass Trailhead, Kinney Creek Trailhead, Byers Peak Trailhead, Keyser Ridge Trailhead, Lake Evelyn Trailhead, St. Louis Lake, Williams Fork, and Darling Creek.

Campgrounds: South Fork Campground and Sugarloaf Campground.

Fishing Site: Ptarmigan Pond.

Located within the Sulphur Ranger District of the Arapaho National Forest, in Grand County, Colorado, and depicted and shown on the attached Map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A, located on the lands described below.

Violations of these prohibitions are punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C §§ 3559 and 3571).
