

Order No. 17-18-03 Forest Road No. 85 (Rattlesnake Road) Closure USDA Forest Service Tahoe National Forest

Pursuant to 16 USC § 551 and 36 CFR § 261.50(b), and to provide for public safety, the following act is prohibited on the Yuba River Ranger District of the Tahoe National Forest. This Order is effective from July 16, 2018 through December 31, 2018, from 3:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., excluding Saturdays and Sundays.

Using an Off-Highway Motor Vehicle, as defined in California Vehicle Code section 38006, on Forest Road No. 85 (Rattlesnake Road), starting from its intersection with Placer County Road No. 9140 then continuing northeast to its intersection with Forest Road No. 85-10, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR § 261.54(a).

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- 1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- 2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions contained in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 USC § 551 and 18 USC §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581.
