ORDER: TEMPORARY AREA CLOSURE

**PROHIBITIONS:**

Pursuant to title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following act is prohibited within the area described below on the Ashley National Forest and Uinta Wasatch Cache National Forest until further notice.

1. Going into or being upon an area, 36 CFR 261.52 (e)

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization including grazing permittees.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

**AREA DESCRIBED:**

The area south of the Uinta Wasatch Cache National Forest boundary beginning at the border with the Ashley National Forest in T9S, R10W section 3 UBSM and continuing west to FSR 090 then the area south of FSR 090 on the Uinta Wasatch Cache National Forest beginning in T8S R10W Sec 30 to its junction with FSR 131 (Racetrack Road) then east of FSR 131 to the Forest boundary in T10S R11W sec 11, then the north of the Forest Boundary to the east until the corners of secs 9, 10, 15, and 16, T10S R10W, then east along the section line till the boundary of the Ashley National Forest. The entire area of the Ashley National Forest's south unit north of the section lines separating T10S R10W sections 11, 12, 13 and 14 and T10S R9W sections 6 and 7. As shown on attached map.

**PURPOSE:**

For the purpose of public health and safety during fire suppression activities 36 CFR 261.53 (e).

**IMPLEMENTATION:**

1. This order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. A map identifying the closure area is attached and made part of this Order.


3. Violation of the above prohibition(s) is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual, or \$10,000 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571 (b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].
4. This Order supersedes any previous Order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this Order in the areas (and/or roads, trails) covered by this Order.
