ORDER NO. 06-15-00-18-399

Emergency Fire Closure

Pursuant to 16 USC § 551 and 36 CFR § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited upon roads, trails, and recreation sites in the Umpqua National Forest as described below and shown in Exhibit A. This Order will be effective beginning on July 24, 2018 and ending December 31, 2018.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Being upon a closed road. [36 CFR § 261.54 (e)]
2. Being on a closed trail. [36 CFR § 261.55(a)]
3. Entering or using a developed recreation site. [36 CFR § 261.58(b)]

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Pacificorp employees in the performance of their official duties.
3. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 C.F.R. Part 261, Subpart A.

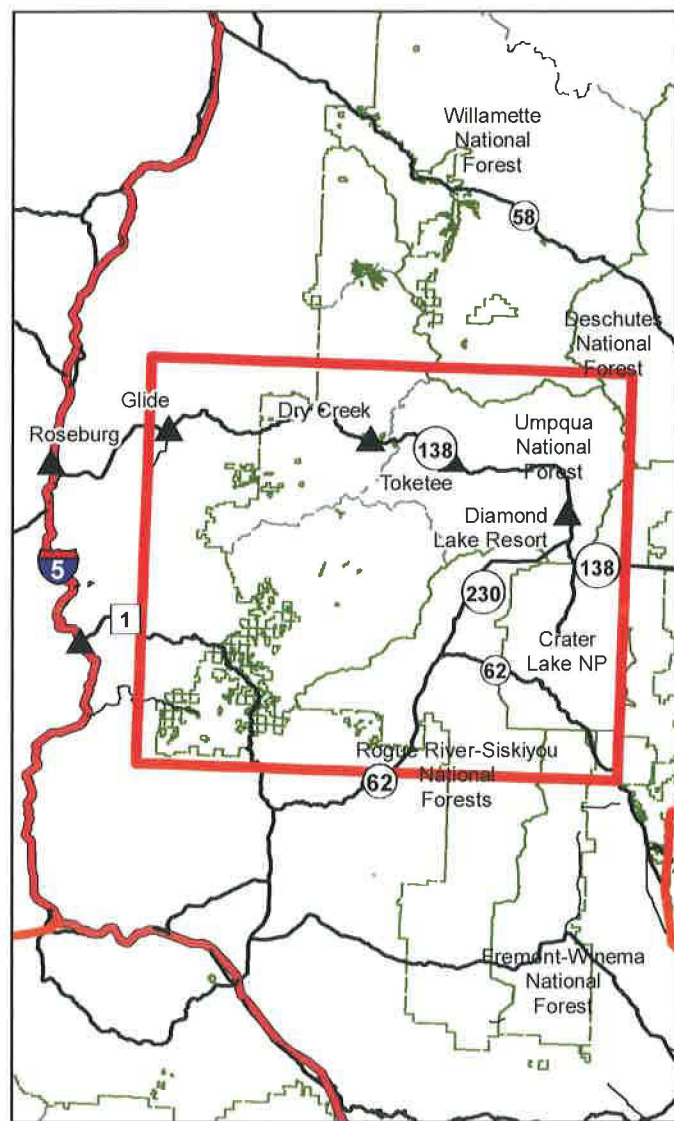
This Order supersedes Order No. 06-15-00-18-398.

Violations of this prohibition is punishable as a Class B Misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both (16 USC § 551; 18 USC § 3559 and 18 USC § 3571).
