ORDER NO. 06-17-08-18-41

MIRIAM FIRE CLOSURE

Pursuant to 16 USC § 551 and 36 CFR § 261.50 (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Naches Ranger District of the Okanogan-Wenatchee National Forest. This Order supersedes Order # 06-17-08-18-33, signed September 7, 2018 by Michael Williams and is effective beginning December 10th, 2018, until May 24th, 2019 unless rescinded earlier.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. **Being on any National Forest System Road**, as described below and depicted in Exhibit A. [36 CFR § 261.54(e)].

FIRE CLOSURE AREA DESCRIPTION:

The Fire Closure Area boundary includes NFS Road 1207 (T.13 N , R.12 E, Section 11) then continues southwest to the end of NFS Road 1207 (T13 N, R12 E, PB 37). Included in the closure boundary is NFS 1200-530 spur road (T.13 N, R.12 E, Section 15)

Roads Closed

- National Forest System (NFS) Road 1207
- National Forest System (NFS) Road 1200 – 530

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Owners or lessees of land in the area, to the extent necessary to access their land.
3. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A. Executed in Wenatchee, Washington this 10th day of December 2018.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 USC § 551 and 18 USC §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581.
