Legal Notice: 90 day comment period for the USDA Forest Service CHUGACH NATIONAL FOREST draft Land Management Plan and draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS). The USDA Forest Service announces the release of the Chugach National Forest's draft Land Management Plan and its associated DEIS. The draft Land Management Plan, when approved, will guide management activities on approximately 5.4 million acres of national forest system lands in southcentral Alaska for the next 10 to 15 years. The Responsible Official is Terri Marceron, Forest Supervisor of the Chugach National Forest. Public comments will be incorporated into a final EIS (FEIS) and final Land Management Plan to be published in 2019. Publication of the FEIS will begin a 60-day objection period. This action is subject to the objections procedures of 36 CFR part 219, Subpart B. Individuals and entities who have submitted substantive formal comments related to the plan or plan revision during this 90-day comment period or during previous opportunities to comment (spring 2015 assessment comment period; winter 2015-16 Proposed Revised Plan scoping comment period) may file an objection.
